A brief ministry history

- Born January 1944. Trusted the Lord Jesus Christ as personal Savior in the summer of 1950. Was baptized in the summer of 1953. Spiritual growth was intermittent as the church my parents were attending at that time did not believe children could be saved, thus I had little or no regular spiritual disciplining until later in life.
- My wife and I attended the Child Evangelism Fellowship leadership training in Muskegon, MI in 1974. This was a concentrated three-month session living on campus. After this I worked as a C.E.F. director for three years training teachers and working in camp. I was privileged to be on the ground floor workings of helping to establish the church related ministries for C.E. F. originating in Minnesota.
- In 1992, I received an Associates of Arts Degree in Biblical Ministries from Brookes Bible Institute in St. Louis, MO.
- Bi-Vocational. While working and attending Brookes, I was interim pastor for Horine Bible church in Pevely, MO where I was ordained. The church was an independent, fundamental Bible Church.
- Full time. After graduating from Brookes, I was called to be a full time pastor in Mapleton, IA. In Mapleton, I was able to be involved in helping to start an IFCA sectional in Sioux City, IA. Also in a pastor's fellowship we started a satellite transmitter for our area in association with Grace College in Omaha, NE.
- During my pastor/shepherding work in Iowa, I continued my education and received a Bachelor of Art degree in Theology and a Master of Ministry in Psychology (*Biblical Counseling*) From Faith Bible Theological Seminary of Milton, FL in June 1998. During this time the President of the Brookes Bible Institute called and asked if I would consider being an instructor at BBI. After prayer and consideration I accepted. I have been here over nine years.
- At Brookes, I was challenged to begin a Biblical Counseling class emphasis in the curriculum (approved by Calvary so credits could transfer to them if a student wanted), a Pastoral duties class, and a Church administration class. These new classes raised good interest in the school and enrollment has increased during that time. We are using these classes to prepare students for Christian work.
- Upon returning to the St. Louis area, I have assisted Maryland Heights Bible Church (IFCA) as they had need of an interim pastor.
- Also I was privileged to help start the Freeburg Community Bible Church in Freeburg, IL. The Freeburg Church now has a pastor, have land to build on in the future and presently are buying the building they are in.
- Much of my weekly duties now include along with teaching, student guidance, and administrating, but also Biblical counseling. Presently along with my teaching duties, I hold additional Bible study groups and fill pulpits on a regular basis in the area when ever possible. Have preached in area churches such as Edgemont Bible Church, Eureka Community Bible Church, Broadway Baptist Church, South County Bible Church and many others.
- In August of 2008 I became Academic Dean of the Brookes Bible Institute.
- In November of 2003, I joined the elder board at Edgemont Bible Church in Fairview Heights.
- Accomplished a doctorate in Theology in May 2006 From Faith Bible Theological Seminary, an Independent Fundamental Baptist College and Seminary.
- I enjoy sketching, cartooning, playing golf, and reading as well as spending time with my wife, children, and grandchildren.
