- I was born in 1973, and raised in a Christian household. I accepted Christ as my personal savior when I was nine years old. I answered the call to preach when I was 16, and delivered my first sermon when I was 17 years old.
- I began my college education at St Louis Community College at Forest Park, but subsequently transferred to Brookes Bible Institute to take classes. After attending Brookes Bible Institute, I earned a Bachelor of Science in Biblical Studies and Organizational Leadership from Calvary Bible College. I also attended Calvary's Seminary. Next, I earned a Master of Fine Art in Arts Management and Leadership from Webster University. Finally, I earned a Doctor of Theology from Evangel Christian University in 2007. I am currently working towards a Doctor of Ministry with an emphasis in Leadership from Louisiana Baptist University.
- I have served as Associate Minister, Assistant Pastor, Interim Pastor, and Senior Pastor of churches in St Louis and Texas. I have been Pastor of Broadway Baptist Church for four years.
- I have been an instructor at several colleges in St Louis. I taught at Glad Tidings Bible College for one year. For the past six I have been an Adjunct Instructor at St Louis Community College at Forest Park. At Forest Park, I have created several new courses that deal with religion, sociology, and the arts, and how they affect/influence people. Five of these courses are now part of a state required curriculum for general education students. I am also an Instructor at Missouri Baptist University.
- I have participated in lectures and presentations throughout colleges and universities in Missouri, Illinois, Texas, and St Petersburg, Russia. I have authored one book that is a required textbook in college nonprofit management programs. My second book, which is a practical introduction to the New Testament for urban/inner city pastors, is scheduled to be published in November. I hope to have my third book published in the fall of 2009.
- I believe in mentoring church planters, pastors and ministers. I do this by serving on the St Louis Advisory Board of Directors for World Impact, an international church planting organization in America. I also serve as a mentor/facilitator for The Urban Ministry Institute in St Louis. Additionally, I serve as a mentor for pastors planting urban churches through the St Louis Metro Baptist Association.
- In my spare time, I enjoy being involved in the arts as a painter and gallery director. I have exhibited my artwork in the United States, Japan, Taiwan, and South Africa.
